Dare to Care

This month École Leo Nickerson officially launched our 5th annual Dare To Care program, a comprehensive and proactive anti-bullying curriculum that has had over a million participants since it was founded in 1999. Maintaining safe, caring, and inclusive communities for our children to thrive in continues to be an important goal for us. Dare to Care is regarded as the most comprehensive and practical bully prevention program in Canada.

Starting in October, all K-6 students began completing weekly modules led by their homeroom teachers. By taking a schoolwide approach to bullying in which we use a common approach, vocabulary, and evidence-based curriculum, we believe that we can enable our students to develop the knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary to navigate peer conflict in a positive manner. If we all do our part, we can change our world so that the number of bystanders is reduced while those actively working to create a more positive community increase.

Dare To Care is a multi-year program and will continue for the duration of the 2024-2025 school year and beyond.
